

OBMP Goals

- 1. Enhance Basin Water Supplies
- 2. Protect and Enhance Water Quality
- 3. Enhance Management of the Basin
- 4. Equitably Finance the OBMP



Goal No. 1 – Enhance Basin Water Supplies

The intent of this goal is to increase available water supplies for all the stakeholders that rely on the Chino Basin and to improve supply reliability.

This goal applies to Chino Basin groundwater, to other sources of water available to the OBMP stakeholders, and to the optimized use of Chino Basin storage to regulate the variability of the available water supplies and improve supply reliability.

Goal No. 1 — Enhance Basin Water Supplies Since 2000...

- Constructed recharge projects to:
 - offset stormwater recharge lost to channel lining
 - increase Safe Yield
 - increase supplemental recharge capacity
- Expanded recycled water reuse: recharge and direct
- Chino Basin Desalters to:
 - recover high-TDS and high nitrate groundwater and put it to beneficial use
 - maintain Safe Yield

Goal No. 1 – Enhance Basin Water Supplies

New or modified activities for 2020 Update... (Table 2)

- (1,4,9) Construct new recharge projects to:
 - Provide recharge capacity in areas necessary to maintain balance of recharge and discharge
 - Further increase capacity for storm and supplemental water
- (1,2,3) Develop/implement storage & recovery programs to
 - increase supply reliability,
 - increase Safe Yield
 - improve WQ
- (7,12,10) Build regional conveyance and treatment programs
- (10, 11) Maximize recycled water reuse



Goal No. 2 – Protect and Enhance Water Quality

The intent of this goal is to ensure the protection of the long-term beneficial uses of Chino Basin groundwater.



Goal No. 2 – Protect and Enhance Water Quality Since 2000...

- Comprehensive basin-wide monitoring programs
- Collaborated with Regional Board to facilitate clean-up efforts
- Developed innovated SNMP to enable recycled water reuse
- Chino Basin Desalters to:
 - recover high-TDS and high nitrate groundwater and put it to beneficial use
 - Assist in remediation efforts (South Archibald, Chino Airport)
- Constructed recharge facilities to enhance recharge of low-TDS storm and imported waters



Goal No. 2 — Protect and Enhance Water Quality New or modified activities for 2020 Update... (Table 2)

- (5) Develop a water-quality management plan to address current and future water quality issues and ensure the protection of beneficial uses
- (6) Develop strategic regulatory-compliance solutions to achieve multiple benefits in managing water quality



Goal No. 3 – Enhance Management of the Basin

The intent of this goal is to encourage stable, creative, sustainable and fair water-resources management for broad mutual benefit to all stakeholders and avoid undesirable results.



Goal No. 3 – Enhance Management of the Basin Since 2000...

- Comprehensive basin-wide monitoring programs
- Subsidence management plan
- Implemented OBMP storage management plan and initiated process to update it
- Developed methods to estimate storage losses
- Entered into the DYY program



Goal No. 3 – Enhance Management of the Basin New or modified activities for 2020 Update... (Table 2)

- (1,2,3) Develop/implement storage & recovery programs to
 - increase supply reliability,
 - increase Safe Yield
 - improve WQ
- (8,12) Optimize all sources of water supply by developing the ability to move water across the basin and between stakeholders



Goal No. 4 – Equitably Finance the OBMP

The intent of this goal is to identify and use efficient and equitable methods to fund the OBMP implementation.



Goal No. 4 — Equitably Finance the OBMP Since 2000...

- Peace and Peace II Agreements, and other agreements to provide incentives and funding plans to construct and operate the Chino Basin Desalters and recharge improvements
- Entered into agreement with Met for DYY to store imported water and provide funding for new wells and well head treatment)
- Obtained low-interest loans and grants to construct treatment facilities, conveyance, recharge facilities



Goal No. 4 — Equitably Finance the OBMP New or modified activities for 2020 Update... (Table 2)

- (14) Develop and equitable distribution of costs/benefits of the OBMP Update
- (16) Develop regional partnerships to implement the OBMP Update and reduce costs
- (15) Continue to identify and pursue low interest loans and grants to support the implementation of the OBMP Update (e.g. Chino Basin Project)








2000 OBMP Process






OBMP Process
