#### C. WATER TRANSACTION

- Consider Approval for Notice of Sale or Transfer Chino Basin Watermaster will purchase 21.215 acre-feet of water from Aqua Capital Management to offset the Assessment Year 2008-09 replenishment obligation. Watermaster will purchase the water at \$321.76 per acre-foot, which is the Assessment Year 2008-09 replenishment rate collected, plus accumulated interest. The transfer will be made from Aqua Capital Management's net under-production in Fiscal Year 2009-10.
   Date of Application: September 18, 2009
- 2. Consider Approval for Notice of Sale or Transfer Monte Vista Water District is purchasing 5.188 acre-feet of water from the San Antonio Water Company. This purchase is made first from San Antonio's net underproduction, if any, in Fiscal Year 2009-10, with any remainder to be recaptured from storage. Date of Application: October 8, 2009

## II. BUSINESS ITEM

# A. 2010 Community Outreach Campaign

Mr. Manning stated this item has been unanimously approved by the Pools and the Advisory Committee. Mr. Manning stated this is the 4<sup>th</sup> year of participating in this program with a number of other parties and commented on the importance of this year's message. Mr. Manning noted this item is included in the approved 2009/2010 budget. A discussion regarding this item ensued.

## III. REPORTS/UPDATES

## A. WATERMASTER GENERAL LEGAL COUNSEL REPORT

1. December 11, 2009 Hearing

Counsel Fife stated a hearing on December 11, 2009 took place and noted no decisions made by Judge Reichert. Judge Reichert stated at that hearing, the purpose of the hearing was to introduce himself to counsel, staff, and the parties and to get an idea as to what will be coming to court over the next few months. Counsel Fife stated the new judge appears to be very interested in our case and noted Judge Reichert was Judge Gunn's research attorney in 2000 when the Peace Agreement was being formulated which means he has knowledge about the Chino Basin Watermaster case. Counsel Fife stated there is a Recharge Master Plan hearing scheduled for Friday, September 24, 2010. Judge Reichert

indicated at the December hearing that due to his calendar being mainly devoted to criminal and other cases, Friday afternoons appear to be the best day and time to schedule CBWM hearings.

#### Added Comment:

Counsel Fife stated there is a map of the Santa Ana Sucker Critical Habitat Re-Proposed 2009 area on the back table which proposes to expand the designation of the critical habitat for the sucker. This notice was published in the federal register on December 9, 2009, and the notice is long and was not printed for distribution. Counsel Fife reviewed the map in detail. Counsel Fife noted comments are due by February 8, 2010 and counsel is encouraging CBWM to comment. Counsel Fife stated he has heard there are going to be extensive comments coming from a coalition of parties who could be seriously affected by the proposed expansion area for critical habitat

#### **B. WATERMASTER FINANCIAL REPORT**

# 1. Financial Update

Ms. Rojo stated at the last ACWA Conference which she recently attended there was an interesting presentation given about the CalPERS rates and their status following the poor investment returns of the past year. Ms. Rojo briefly reviewed the items discussed at the conference including impacts attributed to payroll increases, benefit improvements, and investment returns in light of the current economy.

## 1. State of the Basin Report

Mr. Malone stated the Final 2008 State of the Basin Report is now available on the Wildermuth Environmental and the Chino Basin Watermaster website and ftp sites. Mr. Malone gave a presentation on the highlights of the final report. A lengthy discussion regarding the report and the issue of subsidence ensued.
