



While the Chino Basin is considered one basin from geologic and legal perspectives, the OBMP delineated five management zones (MZs) based on groundwater flow systems that function as distinct hydrologic units. Each MZ has a unique hydrology and unique water resource management activities that have limited impacts on the other MZs. Management, monitoring, and reporting activities for these MZs are discussed throughout this State of the Basin Report.
