#### **RESOLUTION NO. 00-01**

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CHINO BASIN WATERMASTER SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF WATER BOND PROPOSITION 13

#### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHINO BASIN WATERMASTER as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

On March 7, 2000, the voters of the state will be asked to consider a measure variously known as "Proposition 13" of the "Safe Drinking Water, Clean Water, Watershed Protection and Flood Protection Act." This measure will have a profound impact on the state's water policies for decades. The Chino Basin Watermaster is vitally concerned with state water policy and wishes to express its views on the measure.

## Section 2. Description of Measure.

If approved by the voters, Proposition 13 would authorize the State of California to issue bonds worth about \$2 billion. The money will be spent on a variety of water projects throughout the state. In Southern California, the money will be spent for Safe Drinking Water Program (\$70 million statewide), Urban Stream Restoration (\$25 million statewide), Watershed Protection Program (\$280 million), Southern California Integrated [Santa Ana River] Watershed Program (\$235 million), Lake Elsinore and San Jacinto Watershed Protection (\$15 million), Clean water and Water Recycling Account (\$213 million), Clean Water Program (\$35 million), Water Recycling Program (\$24 million), Coastal Nonpoint Source Control Program (\$90 million), Water Conservation-Infrastructure Rehabilitation (\$60 million statewide), and Water Conservation-Urban Water Conservation (\$30 million statewide).

## Section 3. Support for the Proposal.

The projects identified in Proposition 13 will result in more water being available for Californians. Since the state has not yet secured adequate supplies to serve future needs, especially in times of drought, these projects are important to the continued economic well being of the state.

### Section 4. Other.

The Chief of Watermaster Services shall send a copy of this resolution to legislators and public agencies within the area served by the Chino Basin Watermaster and to the Association of California Water Agencies.
