RESOLUTION 00-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CHINO BASIN WATERMASTER LEVYING REPLENISHMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE ASSESSMENTS FOR THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF FISCAL YEAR 2000- 2001

WHEREAS, the Chino Basin Watermaster was appointed on January 27, 1978, under Case No. RCV 51010 (formerly case No. SCV 164327) entitled Chino Basin Municipal Water District v. City of Chino, et al., with powers to levy and collect administrative and replenishment assessments necessary to maintain water levels and to cover the cost of administering the Chino Basin Judgment; and

WHEREAS, the Chino Basin Watermaster adopted an Interim Budget for the first six months of Fiscal Year 2000-2001 on September 28, 2000, which was approved by the Watermaster Advisory Committee on September 19, 2000, in the amount of \$2,206,122 to carry out the necessary Watermaster functions under the Judgment; and

WHEREAS, the parties named in this Judgment have pumped 579.294acre-feet of water in excess of the operating safe yield, which is required to be replaced at the expense of the parties in accordance with the assessment formulas for the respective pools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chino Basin Watermaster levies the respective assessments for each pool effective September 29, 2000 as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Judgment, each party has thirty (30) days from the date of invoice to remit the amount of payment for assessments due. After that date, interest will accrue on that portion which was due as provided for in Section 55 (c) of the Judgment. Following a mid-year budget review by January 1, 2001 and subsequent adoption of a final FY 2000-2001 Watermaster Budget, each party will have thirty (30) days from the date of invoice to remit the remaining amount of payment for assessments due. After that date, interest will accrue on that portion which was due as provided for in Section 55 (c) of the Judgment.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was approved, as amended, by the Advisory Committee on the 19th day of September 2000 and adopted by the Watermaster Board on the 28th day of September 2000.
