**RESOLUTION OF THE CHINO BASIN WATERMASTER,
SUPPORTING PROPOSITION 50,
THE WATER SECURITY,
CLEAN DRINKING WATER,
COASTAL AND BEACH PROTECTION BOND OF 2002**

WHEREAS, In November of 2002 voters will have the opportunity to approve Proposition 50, the Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Bond of 2002;

WHEREAS, the Chino Basin Watermaster fully supports the beneficial impacts Proposition 50 will bring to our communities. This bond offers new funding for water supply and water quality projects that are being implemented by the Chino Basin Watermaster in cooperation with Inland Empire Utilities Agency, such as its water recycling and conservation programs, groundwater management and desalinization projects;

WHEREAS, Proposition 50 offers funding for updating and building new infrastructure to accommodate the economic development and urban growth in the Chino Basin;


WHEREAS, Proposition 50 funds will help protect and expand wetlands in the Prado Basin and restore the Santa Ana River and watershed;

WHEREAS, Proposition 50 is also a critical source of funding to continue the CALFED Bay-Delta Program, including funding for surface water storage proposals and implementation of the California Colorado River Water Use 4.4 Plan; and

WHEREAS, If adopted by the voters, Proposition 50 will provide \$3.44-billion to California for funding water supply, water quality and water security projects, as well as for coastal and wetlands protection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chino Basin Watermaster supports Proposition 50, the Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Bond on the November 5, 2002 ballot.


